


Family Math Resources Grade 7 & 8

Engaging with your child in any of the following everyday activities that build math knowledge in real life.

- Budgeting and grocery shopping
- Drafting fantasy sports teams using stats
- Woodworking/car mechanics/construction
- Cooking
- Planning parties/gatherings (how many supplies to purchase, etc.)

- Sudoku puzzles
- Calculating store sales using flyers
- Scheduling: ask your child to assist you in scheduling family commitments, cleaning, visits from company
- Home repair/decorating (how many cans of paint, cutting angles, etc.)
